There are ladders and a power washer already at the airport just waiting to be put to some good use. Bring your scrapers when you have some spare time and help us get this done so our airport will be looking great again!

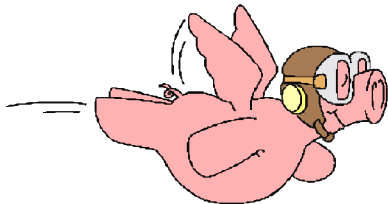
